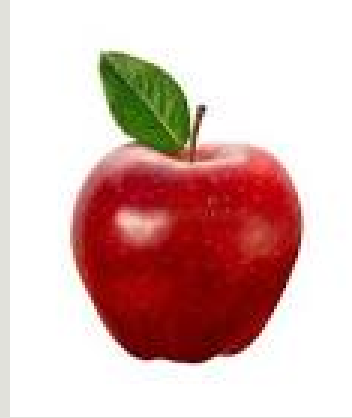

- * Expressive Arts and Design

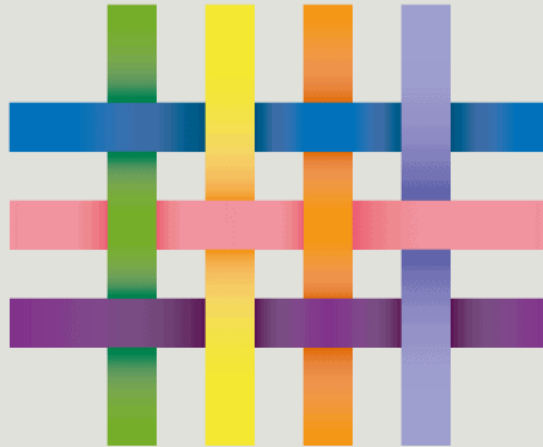
The Characteristics of Effective Teaching and Learning

Three characteristics of effective teaching and learning are:

- Playing and exploring – children investigate and experience things, and ‘have a go’
- Active learning – children concentrate and keep on trying if they encounter difficulties, and enjoy achievements
- Creating and thinking critically – children have and develop their own ideas, make links between ideas, and develop strategies for doing things Statutory framework for the EYFS.
