Dear parents and carers,

We have reached the end of another really successful year at Armley Park and I know the children are all really looking forward to the summer break.

A few reminders...

Debt:

If you owe any money for lunches, milk, nursery fees, breakfast club, after school club or trips, please make sure this is paid as soon as possible. If money is still owed after the holidays, you will not be able to use the services until the debt is cleared. As a school, we still have to pay for school lunches, buy food for clubs and pay our staff so any money outstanding has to come out of the school budget. This means there will not be enough money left that we would prefer to spend the money on.

School lunches:

After the summer, the cost for school lunches will rise to £2.40 per day. This only applies to children in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 who are not eligible for free school meals.

Staffing updates:

We don't have any staff leaving this term and all the children have met their new teachers and support staff. We have some additional members of support staff joining the team in September so you may see a few new faces around school.

Term dates:

We finish for the summer break at 3.15 on Friday afternoon and the children return to school on Tuesday 3rd September at 8.40. Copies of the school calendar were sent home with the reports but there are also copies on our school website -
