

Shapes are Everywhere

Books we will be sharing:



By the end of this topic, Nursery children will be able to:

- Name common 2D shapes and talk about them using mathematical language (e.g. 'corners' 'sides' 'straight' 'flat' 'round').
- Describe a familiar route.
- Understand and use positional language.

Key vocabulary:

Shape, 2D, 2 dimensional, flat, round, straight, curved, corners, sides, position, under, on top, behind, in front, in between.

In Literacy we will be learning:

- To listen carefully to stories and answer questions about them.
- Talk about the characters in stories, the setting and what happens.
- To recognise and notice some print e.g. the first letter of their name/logos.
- To give meaning to marks.
- To write the first letter or more letters of their name.

In Maths we will be learning:

- Numbers 4,5 and 6.
- Common 2D shape names and their properties.
- Different shapes can have different purposes.
- Positional vocabulary.

How you can support learning at home:
