Dear parents and carers,

As we head into the final few weeks of term, there is still lots happening!

There are a few more trips planned before we break up for summer so please keep checking your Arbor account to see if you need to give permission or pay for any of these. Also – if you are unsure of the plans for the trips once you have paid, you can still find that information on your Arbor account. The office staff are happy to help if you are not sure how to find this.

It was great to see so many families at the Nursery and Reception Sports Day last week – thank you for your support.

The new date for **Sports Day** for the rest of school is **Wednesday 9th July** and this will take place in the park if you would like to join us and cheer your children on.

On **Friday 11th July** we are celebrating **Culture Day** across school. Culture Day is all about celebrating what makes us unique and sharing insights into our lives and cultures.

As part of the day we would like children to come to school in clothing that is special to them and reflects part of their individuality and culture e.g. linked to a hobby, your religion, or something that makes you happy. The children need to be prepared to talk to their class about what they are wearing and what their culture/lifestyle means to them.

If you would like to come and share your experiences of culture or diversity with your child's class please contact your child's class teacher as soon as possible so we can make plans for the day.

The teachers have been very busy writing the children's end of year reports which we will send home on Friday 11th July. Please look out for the large white envelopes which contain their reports and also some important information about next year.

On Monday 14th July, the children will be spending time in their new classrooms and with their new teachers. This will be a great chance for them to see what life will be like for them in September. Year 6 have their transitions days to their high schools on different days so please look out for information from their new school about

when they need to attend. On those days, the children go directly to their new school, they do not need to come into school first.

This year, it has been great to see the majority of children wearing the correct uniform for both school days and for PE days. Please keep this going for the rest of the term as the expectations are still the same. For those children who are not arriving in the correct uniform, we are able to provide spare clothes for them to change into and we will send you a message to let you know.

Reminder – Breakfast Club is free from 8:10 each morning but please let us know you are coming by registering on Arbor. This helps us to make sure we have enough staff and food available.

School finishes on Friday 18th July at 3:15pm and we return to school on Tuesday 2nd September at 8:40am.
